FastBridge screening measures are used to provide an insight into a student's approach to reading, addressing the essential early reding skills in phonemic awareness, phonics and automaticity. If universal screening identifies below benchmark skills in the overall composite score, the students' responses to word segmenting, nonsense word and sight word measures will be used for further analysis. When appropriate, the PAST assessment or Diagnostic Decoding Surveys will be used to assist with pro

Description of district's efforts to screen and identify convergence insufficiency disorder

Teacher observations and reading screening scores will be used to identify potential students at risk. Teachers will collect data and document if behaviors such as inability to concentrate, short attention span, frequent loss of place when reading, squinting, closing or covering an eye or sleepiness are frequently occurring. If a correlation between low reading scores and a vision deficiency is suspected, parents will be encouraged to seek assistance from a licensed eye care professional.
