- Swim Passes can be purchased at 20 punches for \$70.00, 10 punches for \$35.00 – punches can be purchased at pool office or school office
- Seasonal Pool Passes (Pool open to mid October): Individual/\$175 and Family/\$375

Pool Parties - If a party table is needed please let us know ahead of time. Private Parties: \$50 for 1 ½ hours plus \$3.50 per swimmer or punch cards can be purchased (additional cost for more than 20 swimmers for an additional lifeguard). An informational contract must be filled out and signed. Cost covers 2 lifeguards for up to 20 swimmers, pool use, and clean up. Additional swimmers and/or time will have an additional charge of \$15/half hour. Contact Rachel Schott at rschott@chokioalberta.k12.mn.us or 320-287-1974. Private Lessons

Ages 4 to adult. 5 sessions for 20-30 minutes at \$85/child or adult. Multiple swimmer family discount of \$5 per additional child. Semi-private lessons up to 3 swimmers in the same level is \$70 per swimmer. Limited space available June 1st-5th, June 8th-12th, or July 6th-10th. Additional dates may be opened once spots are filled.

Tiny Tots: 6 mos-4 yrs. Meets on Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30pm beginning June 1th-July 1st (No classes June 22nd or 24th) for a total of 8 sessions. Register with the office if interested but drop-ins are welcome. Sessions may be prepaid or paid at the pool. Cost: \$64/ 8 sessions per child (each child MUST be accompanied into the water by a parent/guardian/caretaker). Unused sessions can be converted to open swim passes.

Group Swimming Lessons

FOR: Area boys & girls, who are at least 5 yrs. old. Pool depth in the shallow end is approx. 36". Flotation devices are available for lower levels. Students may bring their own appropriately sized lifejackets or puddle jumpers.

Lessons: June 1st - 5th

C-A: June 1-5 10:00 and 11:00 (Level 1 10:00-10:30, level 2 10:30-11:00, levels 3-6 10:00 -11:00)

WHERE: Chokio-Alberta Community Pool

COST: \$55.00 per individual for ½ hour class
\$65.00 per individual for 1-hour class
